ESSEX COUNTY'S BRIGHTEST SHINE AT ASSUMPTION MATH COMPETITION

On Tuesday May 28th 2013, Assumption College School Mathematics Department hosted its annual ACS Grade 7 Math Invitational. 28 teams from 17 schools representing all three local school boards participated. The event is the only one of its kind in Essex County. If the hoots and hollering in the Assumption Cafeteria during the competition are any indication, there will be many more in the coming years.

“The competition is designed to encourage and promote the problem solving skills of students with interests and abilities in mathematics”, says Adam Mills, Math Teacher at Assumption High School. Students were required to complete tasks individually, and in teams, that would challenge their knowledge of the grade 7 Ontario curriculum. “This is an opportunity for highly motivated students to network and engage with their peers from other schools in a stimulating atmosphere” adds Rob Muscedere, Math Teacher at Assumption. “Grade school teachers have welcomed this opportunity for their students; everyone is excited”.
