Policy: **Property Damage/Vandalism/Theft**

B:05

POLICY

The Windsor-Essex Catholic District School Board shall not tolerate vandalism or theft on board property or in its buildings or at board sponsored events. The Board adopts the following definitions:

Vandalism: the deliberate damage or defacement of school grounds, buildings, equipment or books;

Theft: taking for one's own purpose, the possession of goods or chattels belonging to another person without that person's consent.

PROCEDURES

1. In the event that any of the above infractions occur, the Principal or designate shall:
 - a. Report the information to the Police Department
 - b. Complete the Burglaries and/or Malicious Damage Form and forward to the Controller of Facilities Services with a copy to the Controller of Finance.
 - c.
2. Should a student commit any of the above violations, he/she will be held liable for damages and subject to discipline and other procedures outlined in the Code of Student Behaviour (ST:03).
