In keeping with the Mission, Vision and Values of the Windsor-Essex Catholic District School Board, Windsor-Essex Catholic embraces the opportunities and challenges of providing a learning environment in which the teachings of Christ and the Catholic faith provide a distinctive Catholic education for all students within its jurisdiction.

The Board, in cooperation with the Bishop, pastors/priests and the parent/guardian community, fosters the spiritual growth of all students enabling them to become responsible citizens, who give witness to Catholic social teachings by promoting peace, justice and sacredness of human life.

The purpose of this procedure is to provide direction on the process for admission of students to the elementary schools of the Windsor-Essex Catholic District School Board.

Therefore, upon approval, any student within the Windsor-Essex Region, electing to attend a Windsor-Essex Catholic elementary school may attend with the understanding that they respect and embrace the environment and traditions of Catholic Education, and the expectations of the Windsor-Essex Catholic District School Board.

**1. Elementary School Admission Non-Catholic**

Parents(s)/Guardian(s) requesting to register a student in a Windsor-Essex Catholic elementary school, and who are not eligible to direct their school support to the Catholic Board, shall make application through the Principal of the school to the Director of Education.

The application will require the recommendation from the school Principal/Vice-Principal in consultation with, and the approval of the Director of Education.

Principals/Vice-Principals will ensure that all students attending a Windsor-Essex Catholic elementary school will participate in the faith life activities of the Catholic elementary school and respect the environment and traditions of Catholic Education and the expectations of the Windsor-Essex Catholic District School Board.
