YOU MUST CHOOSE ONLY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING FOUR OPTIONS. Students will not be permitted to register in more than one program.

1 CREDIT RECOVERY (35% - 49%)

Credit recovery offers students an opportunity to revisit those areas of a particular course in which they were not successful. You must have achieved a **minimum of 35%** in the selected course in the **current school year** to be eligible for this program. This program runs from **Thursday, July 6 to Wednesday, July 26**. Course offerings are dependent on sufficient enrollment, therefore an alternate choice is recommended. **You may pick a full credit course as an alternate if so desired (see OPTION 2 below).**

2 FULL CREDITS

③ COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

Students have two options to earn credits through cooperative education: **one credit (from July 4 to July 31)** and **two credits (July 4 to August 29)**. Preference will be given to those students applying to the program for the following reasons: ① students in Grade 11 or 12 in credit deficit ② students in Grade 12 requiring credits to graduate ③ students registered in the Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) program ④ students registered in the Summer Company youth entrepreneurship program ⑤ students registered in the Focus on Youth summer program. Enrollment will be limited!

Students can earn **full credits** through e-learning (from **July 4 to August 1**). Course availability is dependent on sufficient enrollment. EXPECTATIONS

All students are subject to the WECDSB Code of Conduct. Failure to comply will result in removal from the program. A student **must attend on the first day** or he/she will be removed from the program.

CREDIT RECOVERY/FULL CREDITS

All classes are from **8:30 AM to 12:30 PM** (credit recovery) or **8:30 AM to 2:30 PM** (full credit). • Students must receive a minimum grade of 35% to be eligible for credit recovery. • A record of attendance will be kept daily by teachers and administration. The **maximum absence** allowed is **one day for credit recovery** courses, and **two days for full credits**. Additional absences will result in removal from the program. • A student who is late for class more than three times will be removed from the program. • Students are **responsible for their own transportation** to and from school. Students should leave the school premises as quickly as possible when class is complete. **Students will not be allowed to use office telephones to call home.**

ACADEMIC EXPECTATIONS

Homework should be done regularly. • Assignments must be submitted **promptly** on or before the due dates. • Tests will be given on a regular basis with a final exam on the last day of the course. • Students must treat all textbooks with care. If a text is defaced or lost, the **student will be charged** with its replacement. • Exams **must be written on the final day** of the course. **No exceptions will be considered.** Textbooks must be returned prior to writing the exam.

COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

All students must have a placement prior to the program start date. • **Transportation** to and from the placement is the **responsibility of the student.** • The **maximum absence** allowed is **two days per credit.** Additional absences will result in removal from the program. **No exceptions will be considered.**

CITIZENSHIP EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to **abide by the classroom procedures** and to **respect** the teacher and their fellow students. • Students are expected to **respect the community around the school** by not loitering or littering. • Students are expected to **dress appropriately** for school. Students failing to do so will not be allowed into the classroom. • Smoking is **not permitted** on school property.
